

## OLD GLEN ROCK PHOTO DISPLAY AT THE LIBRARY

“Yesterday and Today: Glen Rock Through the Ages in photographs” will be the featured display for the month of September at the Glen Rock Library. The exhibit is being presented by the Glen Rock Historical & Preservation Society (GRHPS) and will include photos from the GRHPS collection and current shots of the same scenes. Come take a visual journey back in time to visit Broad Street and Rock Road when they were still dirt roads; the Van Den Berg pig farm on Ackerman Avenue; the Leone Lumber Yard fire; and the Smith-Singer Building when it had three full stories. See what these locations (and more) look like now, in 2014. The exhibit will fill the window display case inside the Library’s front door and the two upright cases flanking the piano. It is open to the public during Library hours.
