NIXON WINNER HEARS FROM HOPEFUL

A Nixon who hopes to be president has sent a congratulatory letter to a Glen Rock Nixon who has made the grade.

Jane Nixon, a senior at the high school, was elected president of the Senate at Girls State last June. The event was sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary. Congressman William B. Widnall sent the story of Jane's election in this newspaper to presidential candidate Richard M. Nixon and, last week, Jane received a personal letter from the former Vice President.

"Congressman William B. Widnall has brought to my attention the fact you were elected president of the Senate of Girls State for New Jersey. Congratulations!" wrote Nixon

"I am particularly pleased to hear of a 'Nixon' who has become a 'winner' and I hope this is only the first of many victories on your road of life. With all good wishes for your future years, sincerely, Richard Nixon."

Jane, who is a member of the student council and features editor of the yearbook, said Friday she was thrilled and happy to have received the letter. In answer to the obvious question, she said she and her parents are Republicans but there is some doubt as to just how an older sister in college plans to cast her vote.

Jane, however, plans to join the area Nixon girls if time from her school work and after-school job permit.
